Since the March 8, 2021 Update, the following activities have occurred:


- Completed installation of mass timber panels and structural steel
- Installation of temporary safety railings
- Delivery and installation of stairs
- Continued electrical and mechanical rough-in activities

- Underground utilities construction activities to resume
- Masonry on cell-block building to begin
- Mobilization of geothermal contractor
- Continued electrical and mechanical installations
- Forming of interior concrete curbing




ARCHITECTURAL & STRUCTURAL SUPPORTS INSTALLED
