The new Royal Canadian Mounted Police Detachment, being constructed just north of the current detachment, will house both municipal and provincial funded RCMP units and support staff. The Net-Zero Ready, 3-storey building will utilize BC-sourced Nail Laminated Timber, and allows the City to showcase our commitment to energy conservation and innovative building practices.

Week of May 10, 2021 Update

Since the April 5, 2021 Update, the following activities have occurred:

- Completed installation of mass timber roof panels and clerestory
- Resumed civil work with the installation of storm sewer
- Construction of roof parapet and continued electrical and mechanical rough-in activities
- Geothermal drilling activities and main floor concrete pouring

Work planned for the reporting next period

- Continued site civil, electrical and mechanical activities
- Masonry on cell-block building to begin
- Geothermal trenching and pipe installation
- Retaining wall installation




STORM SEWER INSTALLATION AND SITE CIVIL WORK
