Week of July 5, 2021 Update

Since the June 7, 2021 update, the following activities have occurred:

- Second floor concrete topping and steel stud installation completed
- Masonry activities on cell-block building continued
- Continued electrical and mechanical rough-in activities
- Retaining wall construction and site surface preparations
- Continued installation of underground utilities
- Installation of piles for covered parking structures




MASONRY INSTALLATION ON CELL-BLOCK BUILDING
