The new Royal Canadian Mounted Police Detachment, being constructed just north of the current detachment, will house both municipal and provincial funded RCMP units and support staff. The Net-Zero Ready, 3-storey building will utilize BC-sourced Nail Laminated Timber, and allows the City to showcase our commitment to energy conservation and innovative building practices.

Week of August 9, 2021 Update

Since the July 5, 2021 update, the following activities have occurred:

- Completed masonry on cell-block building
- Continued electrical and mechanical rough-in activities
- Completed retaining wall construction and installation of underground utilities
- Continued site surface preparations
- Installation of roof insulation, waterproof membrane and roof boards
- Installation of exterior sheathing
- Completed interior steel stud installation

Work planned for the reporting next period

- Continued site civil, electrical and mechanical activities
- Continued exterior sheathing and cladding installation


