Nomination forms are available at City Hall, 10631—100 Street during regular office hours from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday to Friday and online at www.fortstjohn.ca to the close of the nomination period.

QUALIFICATIONS FOR OFFICE

A person is qualified to be nominated, elected, and to hold office as a member of local government if they meet the following criteria:

- Canadian citizen;
- 18 years of age or older on general voting day [October 15, 2022];
- resident of British Columbia for at least 6 months immediately before the day nomination papers are filed (March 8, 2022); and
- not disqualified under the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from being nominated for, being elected to or holding the office, or be otherwise disqualified by law.

CAMPAIGN PERIOD EXPENSE LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 general local election, the following expense limits for candidates during the campaign period apply:

Mayor	\$20,424.40
Councillor	\$10,248.00

THIRD PARTY ADVERTISING LIMITS

In accordance with the *Local Elections Campaign Financing Act*, for the 2022 general local elections, the following third party directed advertising limits apply:

Mayor and Councillor \$1,021.22
