ELECTOR REGISTRATION

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day,
- Canadian citizen,
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the time of voting,
- resident of the City of Fort St. John at the time of voting (resident elector); OR registered owner of real property in the City of Fort St. John for at least 30 days immediately before the time of voting (non-resident property elector),
- not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

Resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the majority of the property owners.

ASSENT VOTING

The Peace River Regional District will be seeking elector assent from **residents living in all communities in the region, regardless of which local government election they vote in**, for four proposed regional services. Formal notices regarding these assent voting opportunities have been published in local papers, and may be viewed on the PRRD website (prrd.bc.ca). Please review the information about these services prior to attending the voting place. **ALL eligible voters** in Fort St. John are able to vote on the assent voting questions.

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

Mail ballot voting is available to ALL eligible voters. Anyone qualified to vote as either a resident, or as a non-resident property elector, may choose to vote by mail.

REQUESTING A MAIL BALLOT PACKAGE:

The City will be accepting mail ballot requests up to 4:00 pm on

Thursday, October 13, 2022. The following information must be submitted to City Hall:

1. Full name,
2. Residential address,
3. Address of the property in relation to which you are voting (for non-resident property electors),
4. Method of delivery of your mail ballot package:
 - pick up at City Hall's office, OR
 - regular letter mail through Canada Post to residential address, OR
 - regular letter mail through Canada Post to an alternate address that you provide when requesting the ballot package,
5. If you are a non-resident property owner please indicate this information as part of your request. A non-resident property owner application will be included in the package.

The City will send out mail ballot packages commencing on or about **October 4, 2022.** To be counted, your mail ballot must be received by the Chief Election Officer no later than 8:00 pm on **Saturday, October 15, 2022.**

CURBSIDE VOTING

CURBSIDE VOTING will be offered on general voting day, **Saturday, October 15, 2022**, for those electors who come to the voting place to vote but are unable to enter the voting place because of a physical disability or impaired mobility.
