

TEMPORARY USE PERMIT APPLICATION – 10715 – 100 STREET

Notice is hereby given that Council of the City of Fort St. John will be considering a Temporary Use Permit for 10715 – 100 Street, legally described as Lot 1, Section 6, Township 84, Range 18, W6M, Peace River District Plan BCP18287.

City of Fort St. John, applicant, is applying for a temporary use permit to allow for a temporary parking lot to be constructed at 10715 – 100 Street (subject property)



The current zoning is RM2 – Multiple Dwelling Housing (High Density) which does not allow a parking lot to be established within this zone.

A Temporary Use Permit can allow a use on a temporary basis that is not otherwise permitted in the City's Zoning Bylaw. The permit may be granted for a period of three years and may be renewed once, subject to Council's approval, for a total maximum operating period at this location of six years. If approved, this permit will expire on June 22, 2023.

City Council will be considering this application at their June 22, 2020 Regular Council meeting that starts at 3:00 p.m.
